The reflection of program music in children's work of music and art

I. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The goal: to perform a piece of program music and display it in art.

Encourage students' self-expression, artistic potential, improvisation and the joy of performing.

To reach the goal, the following **the objectives** are used:

- to promote children's creativity in music and art;
- to encourage young performers to improve their skills by opening them opportunities for artistic expression and improvisation;
- to cooperate and share the artistic experience with foreign and Lithuanian children's music/art schools;
- to promote an interdisciplinary dialogue of music and art.

II. PARTICIPANTS AND PROGRAMME

Students of different musical instrument classes and students developing art skills are invited to take part in the international program piece festival "Music – the visual world of sounds". A piece of freely chosen music (extracts from operas, operettas, ballets, musicals etc.; fragments of improvisation are possible at the beginning, middle or the end of the piece) is performed by musicians either *solo* or ensemble at your own choice.

Art section students from Grigiškės school of art will organize an exhibition based on Edgar Degas painting "The Blue Dancers". Each performer also can make a visual design of the piece of music to be performed. It will aim to reach simultaneous fusion of arts.

III. REGULATIONS

The organizers establish the order in which the festival participants perform. As of 18 March, 2019, the programme of the concert and the performance time will be displayed on the website of Grigiškės school of art www.gmm.lt.

The programme indicated on the application form cannot be changed.

Grigiškės school of art festival is a public event.

Festival concert will take place March 28, 2019, at 12:00 p.m. at Grigiškės school of art.

Registration begins March 28, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. The performers who are scheduled to perform later, are registered an hour before the estimated time of performance displayed on the website www.gmm.lt.
